You assert over and over that elim'g ag subs will create food deserts, but u give me very little analysis.
"Our contentions, then their responses to our contention" is not a valid organization. When u discuss ur contention, tell me their response, and why it's wrong. Just repeating ur orig contention w/o their response does nothing. **VERY ARTICULATE**
Speech we've been way better w/ clearer links to ag subs, etc.

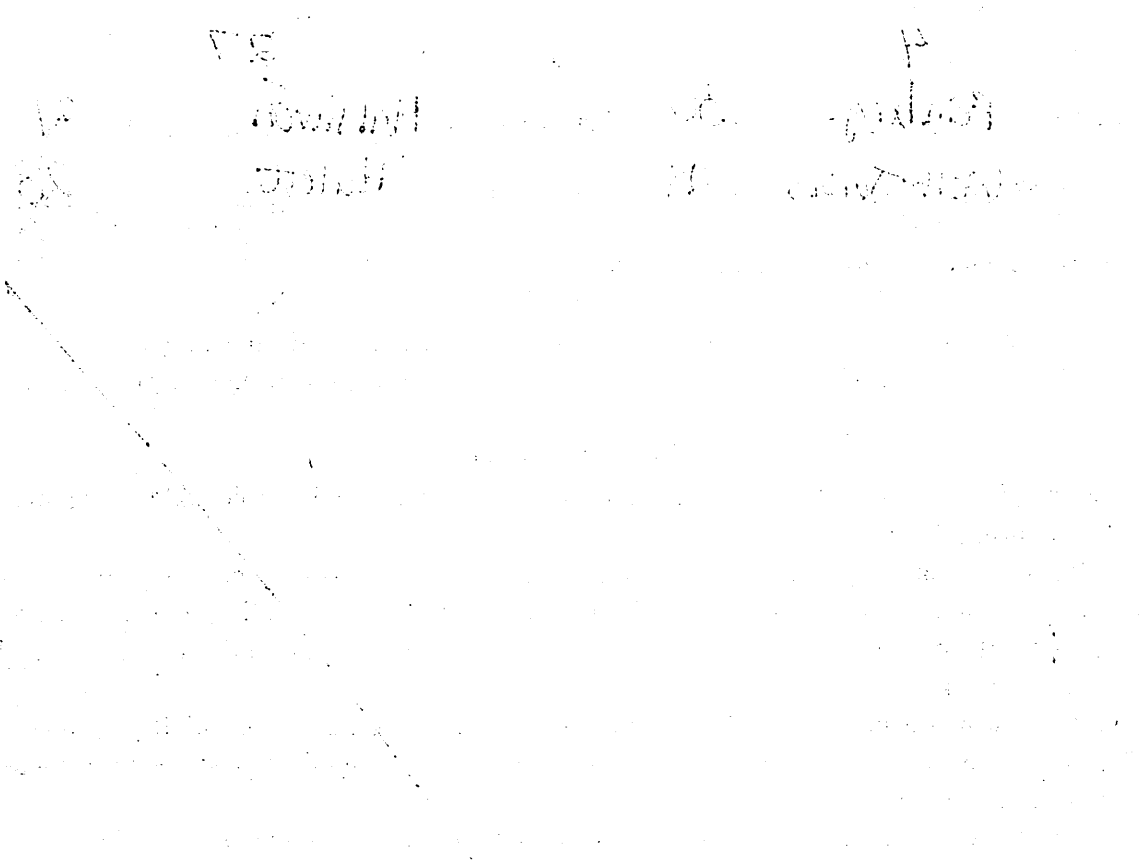
