NEG

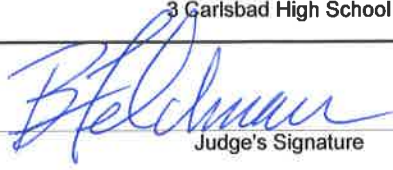
