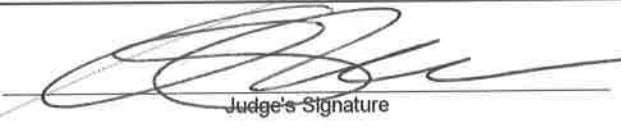
Leena: • When debating, talk to the room, not directly to your opponent. Avoid "You said this, You said that."  
 • Remain standing for cross-ex, don't sit.  
 • Your case was good and flowed... it was well written.  
 • Signpost in rebuttals → you were all over the place & hard to follow

Aadil: • Don't waste C/X time → use it!!!  
 • Good voice ... but SLOW DOWN!!!  
 • Would like to see better support in arguments but you lost me sometimes with your speed & jumping around. Practice your signposting.  
 • Do not simply rely on "cards" to refute. If a "Card" is opinion, and your opponent has an opinion... an ~~and~~ opinion backed by reason wins.

Decision: Went ~~with~~ with NEG because of too many arguments left open by AFF. NEG's support of arguments was weak, but left open by AFF.

- Don't sit during cross-ex
- Speak to the <sup>room</sup> ~~room~~. Avoid "You said, you claim"
- Use your time ... only 4 mins on NEG rebuttal??

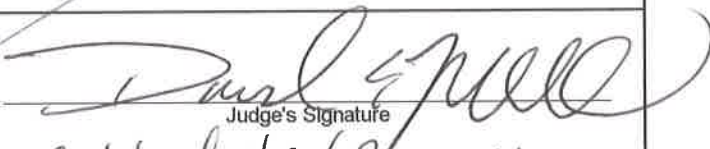

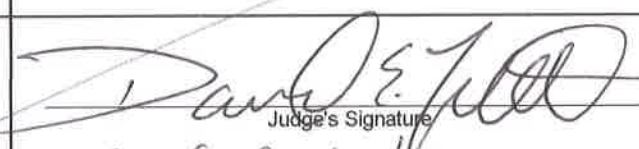
