

IA: You need a clearer answer on whether or not you first. You cannot just extend your own arguments in the IAR without answering the neg's answers. You drop a lot on a spec, specifically the two independent Veterans and a 2nd Argument. The only way you go for on Delev is no link and case spec. You need more. If you are going to hinge the round on Framework you need to spend a lot more time on it.

IN: Don't use prep for the INC. Delev and the card on case contradict. You misexplain the Delev link in the INC cross-x. INR should do more to extend Biopower ^{loss} impacts you already have rather than ^{raising} them.
